County Auditor's Office (CAO) Grants Section Budget Amendment Request

The County Auditor is requesting two budget amendments totaling \$46,190 from the FY 12 Grants Reserve (001-9800-981-9837) to various line-items in the County Auditor's Office (CAO) in the amount of \$45,925 for funding a Grants Financial Auditor FTE position for the balance of FY 12, and to the ITS Department in the amount of \$265 for software for the FTE.

The funding for this position has been included in the Grants Reserve for the past two fiscal years in anticipation of this possible requirement related to workload requirements in the CAO Grants Section.

If the Commissioner Court approves this mid-year request, PBO will need to include ongoing funding for FY 13 within the CAO for this position in the amount of \$91,674, made up of \$90,130 for personnel costs and \$1,544 for operating expenses.

Please see the attached memorandum from COA for further information on this request.

The FY12 Adopted Budget includes within the Grants Reserve (line item 001.9800.981.9837) funding in the amount of \$99,463 for a Financial Auditor/Analyst III position and related costs in anticipation of an increased grants workload. The District Judges approved the reclassification of slot 19 to be the Grants financial auditor/analyst III position should the Commissioners Court approve the budget transfer from the Grants Reserve.

Based on the current workload and the amount of overtime our grants staff is currently working, we are requesting there be a budget transfer from the Grant Reserves to fund the new grants position. For the remainder of FY12, the transfer from reserves should be \$46,190.

This position is required so that we can adequately perform the necessary duties related to the growth in the number and complexity of grants accepted by the County. The types of grants the County is applying for and receiving continues to be more complex in nature. The factors that make a grant more complex include, but are not limited to, a) subrecipients, b) program income, c) types of funding (ARRA), and d) reporting requirements. The greater the complexity, the greater the workload of the current grant staff.

Currently we have 6 FTEs (includes supervisor and 5 financial auditor/analysts) in the Grants division and the workload is equivalent to 7.5 FTEs with 20% overtime. So even with the addition of 1 new FTE, we will still be asking staff to pick up the workload of another 0.5 FTE. Based on current programs, the estimated number of grants for FY12 has been revised to 198 from the 180 original estimate that was made at the time of the FY12 budget submission in April 2011. Please note that the County's acceptance of grants is an ongoing process, so most likely the number of grants will continue to increase even above the projected 198.

RE:

Request to transfer funds from CAR Reserves to purchase Audio/Visual equipment and build-out for 700 Lavaca approved in Commissioners Court on April 24, 2012.

RMCR is requesting Commissioners Court approval to transfer \$80,000 from the CAR reserve to fund an improved A/V automation system and half the costs to build out the "multipurpose" rooms on the second floor of 700 Lavaca.

Approval to purchase these items was made by Commissioners Court on April 24, 2012 as agenda item A2. In FY 2009, the court approved \$80,000 in upgrades to the A/V equipment for the existing Commissioners Courtroom, but the use of those funds was put on hold until the department was ready for the equipment. The department requested the funds as part of the FY 2011 Budget. When the move to 700 Lavaca was approved, the request was pulled. However during the FY 2012 Budget Mark-up an earmark was approved against reserves in anticipation of the possibility that the budget to build out 700 Lavaca would be short.

AGENDA LANGUAGE:

Consider and approve additional funds for the 700 Lavaca audio/visual/broadcast construction and integration project.

BACKGROUND/SUMMARY OF REQUEST AND ATTACHMENTS:

In the fall of 2009, the Commissioners Court purchased the office building at 700 Lavaca St. Included among the many county departments and functions to be relocated to the new building were the Commissioners Court room and Media Service's video production and broadcast facility.

During the early planning phase in 2010, Facilities Management Project Managers requested that the Media Operations Manager ask the City of Austin about their funding levels for audio/video/broadcast infrastructure at City Hall for the City Council chambers, boards and commissioners room and press conference room/studio. Russ Rumney, Manager of Network Services Group responded in an email, stating \$2.5 million for audio/video/broadcast and \$800,000 related IT.

In February 2011, the Media Operations Manager began working with HS&A, the project manager hired by the Commissioners Court to oversee the remodeling and construction on the first 3 floors of 700 Lavaca. 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Group to be the architect for the project, with Harvey Marshall Berling Associates (HMBA) as a partner consulting on the audio/video/broadcast component. Envisioned was a state of the art high definition video facility to replace the current aged standard definition facility in the Granger building.

HMBA's first equipment list presented to HS&A and the Media Operations Manager totaled \$1,461,000. HS&A advised HMBA that the cost was too high, and the number needed to be reduced to less than \$1,000,000. The reductions required changing the quality level of some equipment and the elimination of other equipment.

Subsequently, HS&A hired Flintco to be construction manager for the project. With that, the \$1,000,000 figure was reduced again to about \$950,000 to account for construction fees and bonding. Also, cost of the studio lighting electrical installation was moved from the general electrical construction budget to the audio/video/broadcast budget, an additional \$35,000 obligation. Following another competitive process, Flintco and HS&A hired Zeiner Video Systems (ZVS) to be the audio/video/broadcast subcontractor, providing design, equipment and installation services. ZVS' review of the needs of the county Media Division with regard to Commissioners Court production, general video production and broadcast operations resulted in another modification of the equipment list and overall design of the facility.

While the current funding level will allow for construction of an adequate audio/video/broadcast facility, allowing us to produce Commissioners Court meetings and studio projects, we will not have the level of quality envisioned at the beginning of this project, nor will have the depth of functionality. The multipurpose rooms will not have video production/broadcast capability, and there is no funding for high definition field video equipment or digital editors to integrate with the new high definition facility. There have also reductions/removals of other equipment important to the Media Division staff.

Also, memorandum from the Media Operations Manager to the Director of RMCR is attached.

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

The Media Operations Manager submitted a memo to the Director of RMCR detailing a request for additional funding for the 700 Lavaca audio/video/broadcast project. The total additional funds requested is \$255,000. Staff recommends the Commissioners Court provide that figure, keeping in mind that the total funding for the project will still be almost \$300,000 less than the original equipment list presented by HMBA.

Below is the itemized request in priority order

- 1 \$30,000 for improved automation system for control/integration of several functions including digital recording, signal switching, graphics, file sharing and archiving
- 2 \$100,000 to return the multipurpose rooms to broadcast/record capability
- 3 \$50,000 for digital high definition field cameras and accessories
- 4 \$19,000 for digital editor, software, internal and external accessories
- 5 \$7,000 for serial digital interface upgrade for 4 current DVCam recording decks
- 6 \$35,000 for studio camera supports/pedestals
- 7 \$14,000 for studio teleprompter

ISSUES AND OPPORTUNITIES:

Approving this request will require accessing the contingency funds allocated for the lower three floors construction project managed by HS&A.

FISCAL IMPACT AND SOURCE OF FUNDING:

There will be \$255,000 less in the 700 Lavaca building's contingency fund for the construction/remodeling of the lower three floors.

Video production facility

Steven, we've discussed the 700 Lavaca building's video production installation project on numerous occasions over the last year. One recurring theme of our discussions is the available funds, or more specifically the relatively small amount of available funds. I believe we need to go to the Commissioners Court to ask for additional \$80,000 - \$100,000 to insure that we have a high quality facility. As it stands, we've had to make significant compromises and reductions to meet what I believe is a barely sufficient budget. I'll provide some history of the funding for this project.

In early 2010, the Facilities Management Department's Project Managers for the 700 Lavaca remodeling project requested I get cost figures from the City of Austin on the City's audio/video/broadcast facility in City Hall, including the Council chamber, television control room, news conference room and boards/commissions room. I emailed Russ Rumney, Manager of Network Service Group at the City. Mr. Rumney answered the request with an email on February 9, 2010. The numbers he provided for all locations totaled 3.3 million dollars.

Subsequently I wasn't provided a definitive figure for the budget for the video facility at 700 Lavaca by FMD or PBO, but I stated to the FMD projects managers that about half of City's allocation, \$1,650,000, would be sufficient for our new facility.

About a year went by without much discussion of the 700 Lavaca video production project until an email communication by me to the project managers on February 11, 2011 was answered. I was informed that a new private project manager, HS&A, was going to manage the construction of the bottom 3 floors of the building. Subsequently I've been working with HS&A.

Together with HS&A, FMD and the Purchasing Department, the primary architect, GSC/Lawrence Group, was selected competitively. Harvey, Marshall, Berling Associates (HMBA) is on their team as the Audio/Video consultant. David Harvey of HMBA prepared the initial equipment list including installation costs, totaling \$1,461,631. Neither I nor HMBA was provided a budget figure prior to the

preparation of the list. HS&A later advised David Harvey and me that the cost of the list was too high and we needed to be <u>reduced to under 1 million</u>.

That reduction required a significant reduction in the scope of the project.

The following were either reduced or removed:

- 1 Reduced the video recording/broadcast capability in the multipurpose rooms (from \$94,020 to \$27,180 by HMBA, to \$0 by ZVS)
- 2 Removed the Teleprompter for studio (-\$13,100)
- 3 Removed the Camera Pedestals for studio camera (-\$60,000)

Less expensive, albeit sufficient equipment was substituted for:

- 4 Production switcher for the studio (from \$63,140 to \$28,490)
- 5 Studio Cameras (from \$151,005 to \$52,135)
- 6 Routing switcher/patching (from \$132,419 to \$73,630)
- 7 graphics/character generator (from \$36,650 to \$8,130)
- 8 Main monitor wall for Commissioners Court room (from \$51,220 to \$28,180)

Never included in the equipment list:

- 9 Field production High Definition cameras/accessories (\$50,000)
- 10 1 new Digital Editor (the other 2 do not need replacement) (\$18,000)

Additional Cost Items not listed on the original equipment list:

- 1 \$35,000 for studio lighting, originally listed in the electrical construction budget
- 2 \$50,000 for bonding and fees

Also to be considered are the facts that the Media Division had \$80,000 in its FY2009-10 for new Commissioners Court cameras in Granger that was scrubbed upon acquisition of 700 Lavaca. Additionally the late relocation of the Media staff offices from the 3rd floor to the 1st floor where Media work facilities (commissioners court room, studio, edit rooms and central equipment rooms) are to be located cost \$100,000 plus. We never should have been on the 3rd floor and those funds should not have come from the new video production facility's budget.

The starting point of the 700 Lavaca video facility budget was the question, "how much did the City of Austin pay for its video facilities in City Hall". If you follow the budgetary information, from the 3.3 million dollar cost of the City of Austin's facility, information requested by FMD, to the first equipment list estimate prepared by David Harvey of \$1,461,631, to the immediate reduction of that to 1 million, to the additional obligations further reducing it to \$915,000, the direction has been continuing downward. While we will complete the video facility with whatever budget we have, we will not have a facility that meets my original expectations of functionality and quality.

I don't expect the Court to remedy all the reductions and take us back to the beginning, but we can significantly improve the new video/broadcast facility if the Court provides additional funds. Specifically:

\$100,000 to return the multipurpose rooms to broadcast/record capability

\$50,000 for digital high definition field cameras and accessories

\$35,000 for studio camera supports/pedestals

\$30,000 for improved automation system for control/integration of several functions including digital recording, signal switching, graphics, file sharing and archiving

\$19,000 for digital editor-computer, software, internal and external accessories

\$14,000 for studio teleprompter

\$7,000 for serial digital interface upgrade for 4 current DVCam recording decks

We will ask for additional capital funds during the FY2013 budget process. Those funds will be used to acquire equipment not necessary to meet the mid-summer 2012 deadlines set to have broadcast operations and Commissioners Court recording functions up and running, with will provide the necessary functionality for productions of departmental programs requiring studio and field production. Thank you for your attention to this issue and I'm looking forward to moving forward with you on this matter.

Security at 700 Lavaca Building

Facilities Management is requesting funding of \$151,174 from the Allocated Reserve for the installation of some physical security measures at 700 Lavaca. There is a security assessment available for review that supports this request. PBO recommends that any specifics regarding the level of security or the security assessment be discussed in Executive Session. PBO has worked with FMD on this issue and recommends approval of this request. Security measures at this building have not been previously funded by the Commissioners Court.

The balance in the Allocated Reserve is \$10,534,896 with \$8,889,639 in Earmarks, leaving an un-earmarked balance of \$1,645,257. If this item is approved, the un-earmarked balance will total \$1,494,083. PBO recommends approval of this request.

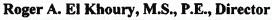

Facilities Management Department (FMD) requests your assistance in obtaining approval to reallocate \$151,174 from allocated reserves to the 700 Lavaca Building, KLAV02. Reserve for Environmental Monitoring

On Tuesday, April 24, Commissioners Court approved a contract and funding source for the environmental monitoring at the TXI project site. However, the item was approved as part of the consent motion and neither TNR's backup nor the motion stated that the budget adjustment was to be treated as an automatic budget adjustment by PBO. Therefore, PBO, in compliance with the FY 12 Budget Rules, must place the budget adjustment on the Court's agenda for specific approval.

In addition, PBO wished to state for the record that the budget adjustment is for a projected four year contract for environmental monitoring and that is not the standard recommendation PBO usually makes. Usually, PBO recommends funding one fiscal year at a time. However, in discussions with TNR financial staff, PBO learned that this contract is not for ongoing monitoring but for project-based monitoring with the timeline for the start and completion of the project still fluid. Approving the full estimated cost of the monitoring up front will help TNR staff react efficiently to changes in the project timeline.

PBO concurs with this request.
