Subject: Project Updates for McAngus Road, Elroy Road and Kellam Road

The Road Maintenance Division of TNR is currently working on reconstructing two roads near Circuit of the Americas located in Precinct Four. These roads are:

McAngus Road Limits SH 130 to Elroy Road (1.6 miles)

> April 16, 2012 Start Date Completion Date June 15, 2012

Percent Complete 80%

Elroy Road Limits FM 812 to Fagerquist Road (1.6 miles)

> Start Date May 14, 2012 August 8, 2012 Completion Date

Percent Complete 10%

Additionally, the Transportation and Natural Resources Department has entered into an agreement for COTA to complete improvements to Kellam Road between Elroy Road and Pearce Lane as follows:

Kellam Road Limits Elroy Road to Pearce Lane

> Early-August 2012 Start Date Mid November 2012 Completion Date

Estimated Cost \$4,100,000

Additional information for **McAngus Rd**:

The design for McAngus Road includes site preparation and drainage channelization with culvert replacement and upgrades as necessary. The existing roadway surface will be recycled in-place down to a depth of 8 inches, cement stabilization will be added and then finished with two levels of a chip seal surface treatment. In October a 1 ½" HMAC Overlay will be added to create a smooth finished surface.

McAngus Road is 80% completed at this time. All drainage improvements are completed and the final chip seal surface treatment will be completed by June 15, 2012. Currently the roadway is open to traffic.

Additional information for **Elroy Rd**:

The design for Elroy Road includes site preparation and drainage channelization with culvert replacement and upgrades as necessary. The existing roadway surface will be recycled in-place down to a depth of 8 inches. Cement stabilization will be added and then finished with two levels of a chip seal surface treatment. In October a 1 ½" HMAC Overlay will be added to create a smooth finished surface.

Work will start on the southern end of Elroy Road where it intersects with FM812 and will progress northward. Site preparation and ROW vegetation removal was completed May 25th. Drainage improvements are scheduled to begin June 4th and the recycling of the existing roadway is scheduled to begin soon after. The final chip seal surface treatment will be completed by August 8, 2012.

Additional information for Kellam Road

The County executed an agreement with COTA wherein they will acquire right-of-way then design and construct improvements to Kellam Road. The improvements will include reconstructing, widening, and extending Kellam between Elroy Road and Pearce Lane. The project is currently under design and construction is anticipated to begin in early August and be completed before the race event in mid-November. Once the improvements are completed the County will purchase the improvements from COTA.
