Re: Transfer of FTE Authorization and Budget for Slot 38 in CJP to the Sheriff's Office

PBO has received a request from the County Executive of Justice and Public Safety to transfer the FTE authorization and budget for Slot 38, Social Services Program Administrator, in Criminal Justice Planning to the Sheriff's Office. The FY 12 amount of funding for salary and benefits is \$21,746 for remainder of the fiscal year based on a June 26th start date. The Sheriff's Office has an outstanding FY 13 budget request for a Social Worker to support inmate re-entry services that has not been impacted by the additional FTE and may be discussed at a budget hearing. In addition, CJP may submit a budget request related to the workforce development program.

The full annualized amount to be transferred to the Sheriff for FY 13 is \$81,481. The FY 13 Preliminary Budgets for Criminal Justice Planning and the Sheriff's Office will be adjusted accordingly.

Fees supported by Revenue


This year, the Purchasing Office has seen higher than anticipated auction fees due to larger auctions being held by the County. Every year, the gross proceeds from the auctions are certified as county revenue and a budget is established to pay the expenditures for the auctioneer's fees. The Purchasing Office's budget does not have sufficient resources at this time to cover the auction fees for the rest of the year. PBO recommends approval of this adjustment to allow the payment of these fees and the continuation of the auctions through the end of the fiscal year. PBO will be correcting this office's FY 13 budget to account for the higher auction fees on an ongoing basis.



Request by Facilities Management Department (FMD) to use an additional \$49,048

from Allocated Reserve for security and signage at 700 Lavaca

Facilities Management is requesting additional funding from the Allocated Reserve for the following two purposes:

1. Upgrade traffic control bollards for installation along the 700 Lavaca plaza previously funded at \$6,500 to concrete base security planters at a total cost of \$35,548. The difference in cost is \$29,048. FMD writes that the planers will provide higher security. PBO notes that they will also be more aesthetically pleasing than the bollards.

2. Install flag poles and exterior building signage at the plaza at a cost of \$20,000. The new signage is required due to certain lease terms. This cost has not been included in previous funding.

PBO recommends approval of this request.

Please note that due to a work flow issue in SAP, PBO could not accurately print out the budget adjustments entered into the system. These budget adjustments will be handled manually until the work order for this issue is addressed.



Request for Allocation of Additional Funding


Facilities Management Department (FMD) requests your assistance in obtaining approval to reallocate \$49,048 from allocated reserves to the 700 Lavaca Building, KLAV02. A set aside of \$500,000 for security needs was previously identified. In April 2012, FMD requested \$151,174 from reserves to address security measures identified for the facility by the security assessment completed on the facility which included exterior and interior cameras plus \$6,500 for bollards. An additional \$29,048 is now required to replace the bollards with concrete base security planters for higher security, which cost \$35,548. Funding in the amount of \$20,000 is also required to install flag poles and exterior building signage at the plaza. A budget adjustment will be loaded into SAP to relocate this funding from allocated reserves to account 001-1405-525-8105, KLAV02.

FMD requests that PBO place this on the Commissioners Court agenda for approval at the next available opportunity. Please contact me at 44579 or John at 44772 if you have any questions. Your assistance is greatly appreciated.
