Request by TNR for \$1,320,525 from the General Fund Allocated Reserve to fund

the implementation of the cover maintenance plan for the closed Travis County

Landfill

On Tuesday, July 3, 2012, TNR updated Commissioners Court on the final cover maintenance plan for the closed Travis County Landfill at 9500 E US 290. TNR has determined that it will need \$1,320,525 in additional funding to implement the cover maintenance plan to comply with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality municipal solid waste landfill rules.

The Allocated Reserve includes an Earmark of \$750,000 for this purpose. The available balance in the Allocated Reserve is \$7,135,740. A total of \$4,997,212 in Earmarks (excluding the \$750,000 Earmark for this project) against the Allocated Reserve leaves an available balance of \$2,138,528. Upon approval of this request, the available balance in the Allocated Reserve will be \$818,003. The table below details which remaining Earmarks may no longer be needed.

Another budget adjustment on the agenda with this request (July 10, 2012 Voting Session) is for \$452,245 from the Allocated Reserve to pay for runoff elections that were not budgeted this year. PBO will update the Reserve balances as it does every week to provide Court with all available resources in the Reserves.

If the additional funding for the landfill of \$570,525 is taken into account along with the runoff election expenses, and the Earmarks not needed or not likely to be needed are updated, the current balance in the reserve would be approximately \$2 million.

Please note that the following Special Reserves and available resources may also be used by Commissioners Court this fiscal year.

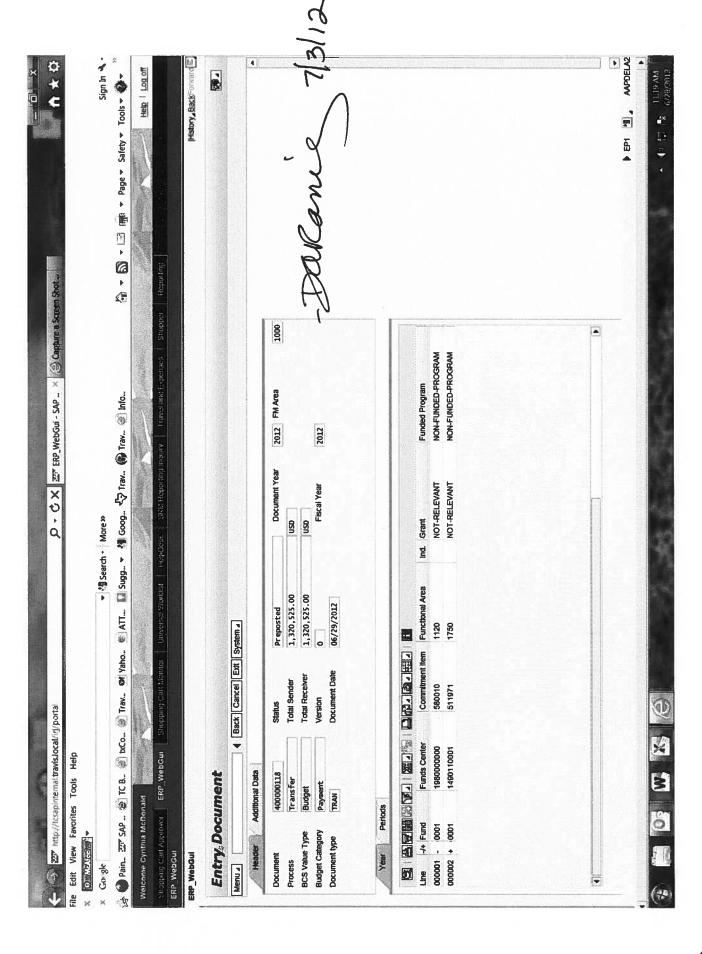

Request to transfer from the Allocated Reserve for expenses related to Primary Election

Runoff.

The County Clerk's elections budget for FY 2012 did not include a direct appropriation for costs associated with a primary runoff election. Since the results of the May 29th, 2012 primary results in the need for both a Democratic and Republican runoff, the County Clerk has requested funds from the Allocated Reserve for costs associated with the election.

The County Clerk has estimated that the cost of the runoff is \$452,245, of which \$305,300 will be reimbursed to the County by the respective political parties. The difference in the cost and the reimbursement is that Travis County is only reimbursed for Election Day costs and not the advanced costs resulting from early voting.

Please note that it is possible that the reimbursement will not occur until FY 2013. PBO has included the full amount of the estimated expenditure, in our estimates for the development of the FY 2013 budget, so the transfer of funds from reserves will not affect the current estimates of FY 2012 ending fund balance adversely.

Election Costs for the Democratic and Republican Party July Runoff

For the FY12 budget, the decision was made to not include costs or revenues for a Democratic or Republican Primary Runoff and instead to request a budget adjustment if a runoff election was necessary. We are requesting that the following increases be made to our budget.

Listed below by line item are the costs associated with this election and the amount that is to be repaid to us by the Democratic and Republican Parties. The remainder represents the costs the County is responsible for, specifically those costs associated with early voting. Therefore, we are asking for a budget increase of \$452,245 with the understanding that \$305,300 will be reimbursed to us by the Parties. Additionally, the Parties will pay \$30,530 for administrative fees to 0128-1200050128-421100.

Request to transfer salary savings associated with an Indigent Defense Enhancement

grant to contracted services.

The Criminal Courts has a rare circumstance where they receive grant funds which are budgeted in the General Fund. In the case of the Criminal Courts, the funds are received from the Texas Indigent Defense Commission for the purpose of enhancing indigent defense services. While these funds are budgeted in the General Fund, the funding is restricted in its use.

A portion of the funds were budgeted in FY 2012 to be used to fund a Business Analyst II position as a special project temp to gather data for the implementation of a software solution to streamline the indigent defense delivery system. However the position completed its task prior to the end of FY 2012 and the position was terminated. The remaining FY 2012 salary portion for the position is still considered grant funds and the department is requesting the remaining balance, \$47,516, be moved from the personnel lines to fund costs associated for the development of the indigent defense delivery system software by KForce, Inc.

PBO notes that the use of these funds is restricted to the proposed or a similar purpose and recommends approval of this request.

Budget Adjustment to Transfer Funds Back to Indigent Defense Enhancement

Project

The Travis County Criminal Courts received Equalization Disbursements from the Texas Indigent Defense Commission (TIDC) in FY11, and again in FY12. The TIDC requires these funds be used for the purpose of enhancing indigent defense services.

The Criminal Courts are utilizing these funds to develop a comprehensive software application that will replace six separate and outdated systems. The new application will streamline the indigent defense delivery system in Travis County. In order to begin the process of business requirements gathering for the Indigent Defense Enhancement Project, a Business Analyst Special Project FTE was created for the period of 10/1/11 - 9/30/12 using funds from the Texas Indigent Defense Commission. However, the requirements gathering phase for the Indigent Defense Enhancement Project was completed on April 30th, 2012, and the Business Analyst FTE was transferred to a different slot for a different project. The termination of this slot has resulted in \$47,516 in unspent salary and benefits from the Business Analyst Special Projects FTE slot.

The Indigent Defense Enhancement Project is currently in the computer programming phase. The Criminal Courts are currently utilizing a Purchase Order to procure software programming services with KForce, Inc. The Purchase Order is structured to provide computer programming services to be paid by the hour. The funding currently allocated for the computer programming phase of the Indigent Defense Enhancement Project is not sufficient. Therefore, the Criminal Courts respectfully request that \$47,516 remaining from the termination of the Special Projects slot be transferred from the appropriate salary and benefit line items to:
