AGENDA LANGUAGE:

CONSIDER AND TAKE APPROPRIATE ACTION ON APPOINTMENTS TO THE STRATEGIC HOUSING FINANCE CORPORATION BOARD OF DIRECTORS.

SUMMARY AND IGR COORINDATOR RECOMMENDATION:

On October 30, 2012, the Commissioners Court issued a Call for Applications to fill two vacancies on the Strategic Housing Finance Corporation Board of Directors. Fifteen qualifying applications were received and, on December 11, the Court identified four candidates it wished to interview for the two vacancies.

IGR recommends that the Court schedule interviews with the four candidates during the next available Work Session on January 31, 2013.

BACKGROUND:

Strategic Housing Finance Corporation

- Seven members; five appointed by individual Court members, two by the Court as a whole
- Staggered six-year terms
- The two Court-appointed slots (Place 6 and Place 7) are vacant, with terms expiring December 31, 2015 (Place 6) and December 31, 2016 (Place 7).
- Not subject to the Uniform Appointment Process

Timeline for Appointments thus far

10/30/2012Court issues a Call for Applications11/30/2012Deadline for receipt of applications

- 12/4/2012 The Court decides to individually review and rank candidates, and then compare rankings at December 11, 2012 meeting
- 12/11/2012 The Court decides to interview four candidates but does not set a time to conduct the interviews

The four candidates are: **Richard Anton**, **Magdalena Blanco**, **Wilmer Roberts**, and **Ed Wendler**, **Jr.** Their applications are attached.

ISSUES AND OPPORTUNITIES:

There are seven members of the **Strategic Housing Finance Corporation (SHFC) Board of Directors**. Five members are appointed by individual members of the Court and two are appointed by the Court as a whole. Appointments are for terms of six years, and there is no limit on the amount of terms an appointee may serve. Appointees must be residents of the county.¹ Because there is overlap between the missions of the Housing Authority and the SHFC, some individuals serve on both boards; however, the two boards are, and should be, independent.

The current members of the SHFC and their dates of appointment are included as Attachment A. The Commissioners Court as a whole makes two appointments to the Board of Directors; the remaining five appointments are made by individual members of the Court.

The two slots filled by the full Commissioners Court – Places 6 and 7 – are currently vacant. The term of the person in Place 6 term will expire on December 31, 2015, and of the person in Place 7 on December 31, 2016. It is for these two slots that the Court will be interviewing the candidates.

FISCAL IMPACT AND SOURCE OF FUNDING: No fiscal impact.
