AGENDA LANGUAGE:

Receive input from the public related to the Community Development Block Grant available from HUD regarding the community needs and project ideas for the unincorporated areas of Travis County and the Village of Webberville for Program Year 2013.

BACKGROUND/SUMMARY OF REQUEST AND ATTACHMENTS:

Under the provisions of Title 1 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (42 USC 5301), the Federal government through the U.S Department of Housing and Community Development (HUD) sponsors the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) - a program that provides annual grants to cities and counties to develop viable urban communities by providing decent housing and a suitable living environment and by expanding economic opportunities for low and moderate income persons.

Annually, HUD requires each grantee to develop an Action Plan specifying the activities to be undertaken with CDBG funds. For the program year 2013 (October 1, 2013 through September 30, 2014), Travis County is expected to receive an estimated \$896,762 in CDBG funds.

To be compliant with 24 Congressional Federal Regulation (CFR) Part 91.105 and the approved Travis County Citizen Participation Plan (CPP), Travis County must hold a public hearing at the Travis County Commissioners Court, and one public hearing in each of the four County

precincts. During these hearings the public will learn about CDBG objectives, eligible activities, available funds, and CDBG project history. This information is available in a power point presentation (in English and Spanish, see Attachments A and B). Additionally, the public will have the opportunity to provide information on community needs and make recommendations for projects. This information will guide the selection of CDBG projects for PY13.

On Tuesday, January 22, 2013, the Travis County Commissioners Court approved the public hearing dates and advertisements for the spring public hearings. Notice of the public hearings was provided in newspapers of general circulation, through postal and electronic mailings, and postings on the County's website, Facebook, Twitter and at the seven Travis County Community Centers. The hearing on February 19, 2013 is the first of five public hearings. A quorum of the Commissioners Court may attend the remaining hearings occurring Feb 20-March 7, 2013.

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

Staff recommends the public hearing, in order to be compliant with HUD regulations and Travis County's Citizen Participation Plan.




INELIGIBLE ACTIVITIES


