AGENDA LANGUAGE: Receive briefing on TNR's recommendation to purchase FleetFocus to replace the existing H.T.E. fleet work order module.

BACKGROUND/SUMMARY OF REQUEST:

TNR is in the process of recommending purchasing a fleet information management system provided by AssetWorks. Both SAP and AssetWorks were thoroughly evaluated before a decision was made. Although TNR supports the implementation of SAP for the financial and human resources systems, AssetWorks was found to better meet needs of the County's fleet operation. This dedicated fleet information management system is ready out of the box and requires minimal customization. The implementation of a dedicated fleet information management system will allow for a more efficient work order processing maximizing mechanic productivity and streamlined management reporting to protect this significant asset investment.

The solution's primary user would be the County's Fleet Services which is a division within TNR. The County has approximately 1,800 pieces of vehicles, heavy equipment, trailers, mowers, etc. that are tracked in the current H.T.E. work order system. The system will be used to maintain the fleet inventory, department assignments, repair history, work order information and provide critical management reports. It will interface with SAP purchasing and fixed asset modules to share real-time information between both systems. Additionally, it will be integrated with the County's fuel management system. The recommended product is a web-based software system that will be hosted by Travis County ITS.

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

TNR is recommending a fleet-specific software solution for several reasons.

- The user-interface is straight-forward and will minimize the time the mechanics are in the system leaving more time for them to work on vehicles
- The software is Fleet specific with embedded links to the nationally recognized parts coding and vehicle classification systems eliminating the need to re-create numbering schemes

- This solution allows full access to the fields necessary for a more effective setup of the system. In SAP, definition of necessary fields for the fleet module were limited because they are used universally and had already been committed.
- Although the solution is outside SAP, it interfaces seamlessly with SAP allowing for the same reliable real-time information depending on how often updates are configured.
- Integrates with the existing fuel management system
- Allows for tracking of parts inventory, a function that is critically needed by Fleet Services

The solution will:

- Include web-based Fleet Management work order and preventative maintenance components
- Interface seamlessly with SAP to provide updated purchasing, fixed asset and labor cost information without the need to duplicate keying information in multiple systems
- Provide straight-forward single set of screens for recording work orders and capturing labor details
- Provide the ability to integrate internal and external fuel transactions
- Maintain a separate parts inventory that can be used to provide notification when parts are low and need to be ordered using SAP SRM (Supplier Relationship Management) module
- Utilize nationally-recognized American Public Works Association/American Trucking Association coding for task codes
- Provide management level reports such as productivity, vehicle utilization, and performance measures and monitors
- Provide thorough replacement planning based on the County's vehicle replacement policy
- Include customer portal available to all drivers to submit service requests when repair work is needed

AssetWorks is a market leader in fleet-specific enterprise asset management software. The company has more than 500 customers, including 7 of the 10 largest cities, 25 of the nation's 100 largest county fleets, and 35 of the most 50 populated cities. The City of Austin has also implemented the same product in their fleet operations. Extensive interviews with them about the product and its implementation were part of the review process. Attachment A lists some of the company's customers.

Implementation of the chosen system will be a coordinated effort between TNR, ITS, and BEFIT. Discussions will continue to take place with each department to ensure a successful and seamless transition is made from H.T.E. to the new fleet system. The two outstanding issues are the costs associated that would be incurred by BEFIT for

programming related to the interface and server requirements and help desk support to be provided by ITS. A formal technology request has been submitted to ITS.

ISSUES AND OPPORTUNITIES:

FISCAL IMPACT AND SOURCE OF FUNDING:

Funding sources will be discussed in detail in conjunction with the overall BEFIT agenda item expected later in April. Below are the itemized costs for the purchase of the recommended solution.
