- WHEREAS, Play time is critical to the physical, emotional and cognitive development of children; and
- WHEREAS, Austin is Playful City USA community and is working to create resources to support healthier lifestyles including parks and playgrounds so our citizen have ample amenities for outdoor recreation; and
- WHEREAS, Currently there are 300 children who attend the NYOS Charter School Kramer Campus, grades PreK-3, who do not have suitable playground equipment to enjoy; and
- WHEREAS, Let's Play, is a community partnership led by Dr. Pepper Snapple Group to get kids and families active nationwide and the first Let's Play initiative is a \$15 million, three-year commitment to KaBOOM! to build or fix up 2,000 playgrounds by the end of 2013, benefitting an estimated five million children across North America; and
- WHEREAS, Volunteers from Dr. Pepper Snapple Group, NYOS Charter School and the community have worked with hundreds of volunteers to build a new playground in one day; and
- WHEREAS, The youth-inspired playground at NYOS Charter School Kramer Campus will contribute to a stronger community and healthier, happier children;
