SUBJECT: Total Losses

Proposed Motion:

Consider and take appropriate action on automobile total loss claim recommendations for the period March 1, 2011 through December 31, 2012.

Summary and Staff Recommendation:

Staff recommends that the total loss claims be paid as proposed.

The County's third party administrator has inspected the total loss vehicles and determined their actual cash value (ACV). The Risk Management fund pays the ACV and pursuant to amended Chapter 34, §34.001, subsection (h), the Capital Acquisition Reserve fund (CAR) pays the difference of the ACV and the cost of a replacement vehicle. The Risk Management fund also pays for all equipment associated with the replacement vehicle.

Please note due to Ford discontinuing the Crown Victoria police vehicles, TCSO is now replacing their fleet with the Chevrolet Tahoes, at a cost of approximately \$8,500 more per vehicle. This increase has been included in the amount requested from the CAR Fund.

Budgetary and Fiscal Impact:

The attached spreadsheet shows the fiscal impact on the Risk fund in the total amount of \$235,868.00; \$135,241.00 for ACV and \$100,627.00 for equipment. The total amount for the CAR fund is \$194,502.00, which includes \$400.00 in buyboard fees. The total transfer amount for your approval is \$430,370.00.

DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT: Deputy Steven Moore was assisting Buda PD with a collision in the 15200 block of IH-35. Unit 3092 had emergency lights activated and was parked diagonally across the inside and center lanes. Reflective traffic cones were in place directing traffic to the outside lane. Deputy Moore was wearing his ANSI approved traffic vest and using his department issued flashlight with orange cone to direct vehicles. He was approximately 75 feet north of his unit when a motorcycle disregarded the traffic flow and warning devices and continued southbound in the inside lane, striking the parked county unit, causing extensive damage. Subrogation has been received by the third party's insurance carrier.

RECOMMENDATION: JI Companies has reviewed the loss notice and confirmed incident with the county supervisor. Unit 3092 has been inspected and rendered a structural total loss. Market valuation was completed and the ACV is \$13,750.00. Custom equipment and installation fees total \$12,061.00, to include video camera, MDC mount, LED's, siren, controller, speaker, gun mount, flashlight holder/charger, fire extinguisher and wiring harness.

DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT: Deputy Ralph Cisneroz was seated inside stationary county unit 3231 conducting off duty traffic control for a road closure in the 11110 block of South IH-35 at FM1626. Traffic cones were in place. A third party vehicle (red Chevy Camaro) stopped and was waived on by Deputy Cisneroz. Another third party vehicle (blue Ford pickup) vehicle came from the rear and without slowing, struck the Chevy Camaro and then continued and struck the county vehicle, causing extensive damage. It was later determined that the driver of the blue Ford pickup was intoxicated. Subrogation has been received by the third party's insurance carrier.

RECOMMENDATION: JI Companies has reviewed the loss notice and confirmed incident with the county supervisor. Unit 3231 has been inspected and rendered a structural total loss. Market valuation was completed and the ACV is \$14,050.00. Custom equipment and installation fees total \$12,061.00, to include video camera, MDC mount, LED's, siren, controller, speaker, gun mount, flashlight holder/charger, fire extinguisher and wiring harness.

DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT: Deputy Ricky Lane was responding to a call off Brandt Road. He was traveling northbound in the 11100 block of IH-35 frontage road driving county unit 3107. A third party vehicle, traveling northbound on IH-35 proper, exited the Slaughter Creek overpass and came to a near complete stop in an attempt to make an illegal turn onto Boca Raton Drive with the intent to go to a convenience store. As he was crossing the frontage road, he was struck by Deputy Lane. The impact caused extensive damage to the county unit. Subrogation has been received by the third party's insurance carrier.

RECOMMENDATION: JI Companies has reviewed the loss notice and confirmed incident with the county supervisor. Unit 3107 has been inspected and rendered a structural total loss. Market valuation was completed and the ACV is \$14,100.00. DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT: Deputy Thomas Popp was enroute to St. David's Hospital for a follow up investigation. He was westbound on 32nd Street at the IH-35 overpass and as he went through the intersection of the southbound service road, a third party ran a red light and struck the county unit, causing extensive damage to both vehicles. Subrogation claim has been turned over to the County Attorney's office to pursue.

DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT: Incident and damages were discussed with county supervisor Sgt. D. Fuller. She advised Deputy Demetrio Medina, driving county unit 3093, and Deputy Miguel Reyna, driving county unit 2873, were dispatched to attempt to locate loose livestock (loose horse on SH130). Deputy Medina was in the lead, northbound on the entrance ramp to SH130 from FM 812, and was looking and spotlighting the field to his right searching for the horse. Deputy Reyna was behind Deputy Medina, also northbound on the entrance ramp to SH130 from FM812, and was looking and spotlighting the field to his left searching for the horse. Unaware that Deputy Medina had slowed his forward movement, Deputy Reyna rear ended Deputy Medina, causing heavy damage to unit 2873, which has since been repaired, and totaling unit 3093.

CORRECTIVE ACTION: Deputy Reyna received 10 hours suspension without pay and no take home unit for four months. If applicable, Deputy Reyna would be assessed 4 vehicle safety points.

RECOMMENDATION: JI Companies has reviewed the loss notice and confirmed incident with the county supervisor. Unit 3093 has been inspected and rendered a structural total loss. Market valuation was completed and the ACV is \$13,600.00. Custom equipment and installation fees total \$12,061.00, to include video camera, MDC mount, LED's, siren, controller, speaker, gun mount, flashlight holder/charger, fire extinguisher and wiring harness.

DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT: Deputy Ricky Lane was eastbound on Slaughter Lane and had a red light. He observed the vehicle directly in front of him run the red light and activated his overhead lights and began pursuit to stop the violator. As Deputy Lane entered the intersection with southbound MoPac, a third party, who had a green light, struck the county unit, front end to front end. The impact caused the third party's vehicle to roll onto its side. Both vehicles sustained extensive damage and both drivers were injured. Third party's bodily injury claim is pending with the County Attorney's office.

CORRECTIVE ACTION: Deputy Lane received 20 hours suspension without pay. If applicable, Deputy Lane would be assessed 5 vehicle safety points.

RECOMMENDATION: JI Companies has reviewed the loss notice and confirmed incident with the county supervisor. Unit 3472 has been inspected and rendered a structural total loss. Market valuation was completed and the ACV is \$15,744.00. The third party vehicle behind him was unable to stop and struck the rear of the county unit, pushing it into the back of the vehicle in front of him, who in turn was pushed into yet another vehicle in front of him. DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT: A third party driver was traveling approximately 40 mph westbound on FM2222. When he came around the blind corner at Mesa, he had to slam on his brakes in order to stop at the traffic light that had turned red. County employee Ernest Garcia, driving county unit SU3271, was behind the third party driver and was unable to stop safely before colliding into the back of third party's Dodge Dakota. County employee was cited for failure to maintain a safe distance. We are still in the process of settling the third party claim.
