ORDER EXEMPTING PURCHASE OF DISINFECTION SERVICES OF WATERLINES AT THE TRAVIS COUNTY CORRECTIONAL COMPLEX AT DEL VALLE FROM REQUIREMENTS OF THE COUNTY PURCHASING ACT

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Travis County has the authority to exempt the purchase of an item necessary to protect the public health or safety of the residents of the county from the competitive bidding requirements of the County Purchasing Act, Loc. Gov't. Code Ann.§ 262.024, and

WHEREAS, the County desires to have the disinfection services performed by Chlor-Serv, Inc., and

WHEREAS, the performance of disinfection services of the waterlines at the Travis County Correctional Complex at Del Valle are necessary to protect the public health or safety of the residents of the county.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commissioners Court of Travis County hereby orders that the performance of disinfection services of the waterlines at the Travis County Correctional Complex at Del Valle, is exempt from the requirements of the County Purchasing Act for competitive bidding or proposal pursuant to, TEX. LOC. GOV'T. CODE ANN.§ 262.024(a)(2).
