Agenda Language: Approve contract award for Networked Evidence Lockers, RFP No. 1306-020-JH, to the highest qualified respondent, Southwest Solutions Group Inc.

Purchasing Recommendation and Comments: Purchasing concurs and recommends approval of requested action. This procurement action meets the compliance requirements as outlined by the statutes.

The Travis County Sheriff's Office identified the requirement for Networked Evidence Lockers that contain refrigerated units, associated software, and technical support for five separate locations within Travis County. This temporary evidence storage capability will allow access to lockers using existing HID cards, provide an electronic chain of custody, secure units to maintain biological evidence using refrigeration, and provide increased temporary storage capacity.

RFP No. 1306-020-JH for Networked Evidence Lockers, was issued on Bidsync. Two proposals were received on August 5, 2013. Southwest Solution Group Inc. demonstrated expertise, technical capabilities and the services required through their selection of quality equipment, hardware and software at an exceptional price, a solution that best fits Travis County Sheriff's Office request for proposal. Therefore, it is the recommendation to award a contract to Southwest Solutions Group Inc, as its proposal met all county requirements.

Proposed Motion:

Approve recommendation for awarding RFP No. 1306-020-JH Networked Evidence Lockers.

Summary for Staff Analysis:

The Travis County Sheriff's Office identified the requirement for Networked Evidence Lockers that contain refrigerated units, associated software, and technical support for five separate locations within Travis County. This temporary evidence storage capability will allow access to lockers using existing HID cards, provide an electronic chain of custody, secure units to maintain biological evidence using refrigeration, and provide increased temporary storage capacity. Two vendors submitted proposed solutions for this requirement. Southwest Solutions Group Inc. and Law Enforcement Intelligent Devices, Inc. (LEID).

Travis County Sheriff's Office is recommending that Southwest Solutions Group Inc., as the best value proposer, be awarded RFP No. 1306-020-JH. Southwest Solution Group Inc. has demonstrated through their selection of quality equipment, hardware and software at an exceptional price, a solution that best fits Travis County Sheriff's Office request for proposal.
