**Agenda Language**: Approve Modification No. 9 to Interlocal Agreement No. 4400000347, Austin Travis County Integral Care for the Community Action Network Policy Forum

➤ Purchasing Recommendation and Comments: Purchasing concurs with department and recommends approval of requested action. This procurement action meets the compliance requirements as outlined by the statutes.

Travis County Health and Human Services and Veteran Services (TCHHSVS) is requesting funding for the 2013 Austin Travis County Integral Care (ATCIC) Community Action Network Forum on November 8, 2013. ATCIC's goal is to increase awareness of health, social and human service needs in the community and to involve a wide variety of organizations in addressing these needs; by conducting ongoing assessments and developing plans of action for finding resources.

Modification No. 9 will contribute \$2,900 to assist with the audio visual, materials, and facility costs associated with the forum.

Modification No. 8 corrected financial language regarding fiscal payments within different fiscal years.

Modification No. 7 renewed the agreement for an addition one year period from January 1, 2013 through December 31, 2013. The funds for this renewal period were \$63,096.

Modification No. 6 added \$2,900 to the agreement. The not to exceed amount was \$81,700.

Modification No. 5 renewed the agreement from October 1, 2011 through December 31, 2012. The funds for this renewal period were \$78,870.

Modification No. 4 changed the name of the agency to Austin Travis County Integral Care effective October 1, 2009.

Modification No. 3 renewed the agreement for an additional one year period from October 1, 2006 through September 30, 2007. The funds for this renewal period were \$63,096.

Modification No. 2 added an Immigration Assessment study to the consulting agreement.

Modification No. 1 added \$5,000 to the agreement for consulting services. The not to exceed amount was \$58,092.

# **Proposed Motion:**

Consider and take appropriate action regarding Travis County Health and Human Services and Veterans Service request to approve a modification to a contract with the Austin Travis County Integral Care Community Action Network (CAN) Interlocal.

# **Summary and Staff Recommendations:**

Since 1998, Travis County has helped fund the activities of the Community Action Network (CAN) through a contract with the Austin Travis County Mental Health and Mental Retardation, now known as Austin Travis County Integral Care. CAN's goal is to increase awareness of health, social and human service needs in the community and to involve a wide variety of organizations in addressing these needs. The CAN conducts an ongoing assessment of community needs, develops action plans for finding the resources to address these needs and evaluates the effectiveness of resources used. Travis County funds pay a portion of the salaries of the CAN Executive Director and Executive Assistant.

For the second year, the CAN will be convening a full-day forum to address the growing inequities in the Austin/Travis County community. They will education over 200

participants on current and future economic, political, community engagement and demographic trends that will impact our community in future years. They will learn about and identify cross-cutting, collaborative strategies and associated barriers that need to be overcome to move the community in the right trajectory and towards greater equity and opportunity for all people.

Aligning with CAN's role as a connector, convener and informer, this policy forum will include a diverse array of participants from across issue areas and government, non-profit and private sectors. In addition to individuals and organizations who actively participate within the CAN network, CAN is inviting other stateholders and community leaders who are working within the realm of CAN's Dashboard and Strategic Framework for Action to join the Conversation.

## **Issues and Opportunities:**

The cost of the forum will total \$7,180 which includes costs for 250 participants for a full day. The University of Texas will provide facilities and A/V equipment, in-kind plus \$1,300 to help off-set the cost of the food for the event. Participants will pay a fee of \$20 to attend. The CAN is asking Travis County for \$2,900 to assist with A/V costs, materials, parking and facilities costs not covered by the University of Texas and two sub-contractors to manage technology, web assistance and leg-work.

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# AMENDMENT OF INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN TRAVIS COUNTY AND

# AUSTIN-TRAVIS COUNTY MENTAL HEALTH AND MENTAL RETARDATION CENTER, DOING BUSINESS AS AUSTIN TRAVIS COUNTY INTEGRAL CARE FOR SERVICES OF CAN DIRECTOR, STAFF AND CAN ACTIVITIES

(2013 Renewal Term Services)

This Amendment ("Amendment") of the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement for CAN ("Community Action Network") related services, the Initial Term of which was effective October 1, 2001, and terminated September 30, 2002 ("CAN Interlocal"), with extensions and renewals as further described herein, is entered into by the following parties: Travis County, a political subdivision of the State of Texas ("County"), and Austin -Travis County Mental Health and Mental Retardation Center, d.b.a. "Austin-Travis County Integral Care" ("Center," or "ATCIC"), the Mental Health and Mental Retardation Authority designated by the State of Texas for Travis County and the incorporated municipalities therein pursuant to Texas Health and Safety Code, Chapters 531 and 534, and other applicable statutes.

#### RECITALS

County, and Center (the "Parties,") entered into the CAN Interlocal to provide services related to the operation and activities of CAN, the Initial Term of which commenced on October 1, 2001, and terminated on September 30, 2002.

Section 2.2 of the CAN Interlocal provides for the automatic renewal of the CAN Interlocal for additional one-year terms beginning on October 1 of each successive year for renewal terms possible through September 30, 2011; and, as amended, for renewal terms possible through December 31, 2018.

The CAN Interlocal provides for changes to the agreement when set forth in writing and signed by all Parties.

County and Center have previously allowed the CAN Interlocal to renew, either automatically by its terms or by written agreement, with the current term beginning January 1, 2013, and continuing through December 31, 2013 ("2013 Renewal Term").

County and Center now desire to amend the CAN Interlocal to reflect mutually agreed upon changes in the terms for the 2013 Renewal Term.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual benefits received by these changes, and other good and adequate consideration as specified herein, the Parties agree to amend the CAN Interlocal as follows:

#### 1.0 AGREEMENT TERM

1.1 Renewal Term. The Parties agree that the terms of this Amendment are applicable to the remaining portion of the 2013 Renewal Term.

#### 2.0 MAXIMUM AMOUNT

2.1 <u>Amended Maximum Amount</u>. The Parties agree to amend Section 4.1.1, "Maximum Amount," by adding the following:

#### 4.1.1-2013 Amendment

- (a) 2013 Renewal Term Amended Maximum Amount. In consideration of full and satisfactory performance of the services and activities referred to in this Agreement during the 2013 Renewal Term, as amended in this document, County shall provide additional Contract Funds (Amendment Funds) in an amount not to exceed Two Thousand, Nine Hundred Dollars (\$2,900.00), for a new total Maximum Amount for the 2013 Renewal Term of Sixty-Five Thousand, Nine Hundred and Ninety-Six Dollars (\$65,996.00).
- 2.2 <u>Payments Amended 2013 Renewal Term.</u> The Parties agree that, during the 2013 Renewal Term, as amended herein, County shall continue to pay Contractor Five Thousand, Two Hundred and Fifty-Eight Dollars (\$5,258.0) per month pursuant to the terms of the Agreement; and County will pay the additional Amendment Funds provided under this Amendment within thirty (30) days of receipt of a complete and correct invoice reflecting the completion of the obligations set forth in this Amendment and documentation of expenses to be reimbursed under this Amendment.

#### 3.0 ENTIRE AGREEMENT

- 3.1 Attachments. The Parties agree to amend Section 17.0, "Entire Agreement," by adding the following:
  - 17.3-a 2013 Amendment Attachments. The attachments enumerated and denominated below and attached to this Amendment as Exhibit 1 are hereby made a part of this Amendment, and constitute promised performances by Center in accordance with all terms of the Agreement as amended.
    - (i) Program Cover Page (Form #2)
    - (ii) Program Budget (Form #4)
    - (iii) Program Budget Narrative (Form #5)
    - (iv) Program Funding Summary (Form #7)
    - (v) Subcontracted Expenses Form (Form #8)

The above attachments are added to the Agreement by this Amendment; all Attachments set forth in the 2013 Renewal remain in full force and effect.

#### 4.0 AGREEMENT TERMS.

- 4.1 Remaining Terms. The Parties agree that all terms and conditions of the Agreement not specifically amended by this Amendment remain in full force and effect.
- 4.2 <u>Amendment Services</u>. The Parties agree that the additional funds added by this Amendment are consideration for the services to be provided by Contractor related to the Policy Forum as described in the 2013 Renewal Term document.

#### 5.0 INCORPORATION

5.1 County, and Center hereby incorporate the CAN Interlocal into this Amendment. Except for the changes made in this Amendment, County and Center hereby ratify all the terms and conditions of the CAN Interlocal as amended. The CAN Interlocal with the changes made in this Amendment, constitutes the entire agreement among the Parties and supersedes any prior undertaking or written or oral agreements or representations among the Parties.

#### 6.0 EFFECTIVE DATE

6.1 This Amendment is effective when it is approved and signed by the Travis County Commissioners Court and Center. This CAN Interlocal Agreement, as amended, shall remain in effect until further modified or terminated by the Parties.
