Agenda Language: Approve contract award for Hunters Bend Road Sidewalk Improvements project, IFB No. B1401-004-LP, to the lowest bidder, Ceda-Tex Services, Inc.

- **Purchasing Recommendation and Comments:** Purchasing concurs with department and recommends approval of requested action. This procurement action meets the compliance requirements as outlined by the statutes.
- The Hunters Bend Sidewalk Improvements Project is a project consisting primarily of installation of 1600 linear feet of concrete sidewalk on Hunters Bend Road between Austin Colony Boulevard and Red Tail Drive in eastern Travis County (Precinct 1). The project includes removal of obstructions, concrete sidewalk, temporary and permanent erosion control and traffic control, all in accordance with Travis County specifications and requirements.
- On February 6, 2014, seven (7) bids were received for the Subject Project. However two of the bids were non-responsive due to not submitting the required bid form. Therefore five (5) responsive bids were accepted, in which the bids ranged from \$118,120.78 to \$181,744.10.
- As a result, TNR and Purchasing recommends awarding a contract to the lowest responsive bidder, Ceda-Tex Services, Inc., in the amount of \$118,120.78.

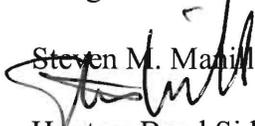

TNR hereby requests that the Purchasing Department place the following item on the Commissions Court Agenda for the April 8, 2014 voting session:

Requested Motion: Consider and take appropriate action on the recommendation to award the construction contract for the Hunters Bend Sidewalk Improvements project to Ceda-Tex Services, Inc.

Project Description

Hunters Bend Road is located in eastern Travis County, Precinct One. The improvements involve installing one pedestrian sidewalk along Hunters Bend Road from Austin Colony Boulevard to Red Tails Drive. Hunters Bend Road experiences high traffic volume at times throughout the day because it is a major entrance to several sections of the Austin Colony subdivision. The sidewalk will improve safety along Hunters Bend Road by providing a walkway that will eliminate the need for pedestrians to walk in the street. The sidewalk will be constructed in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and Architectural Barriers Regulations of Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation (TDLR).

Summary and Recommendations

The Hunters Bend Road Sidewalk project is a voter approved 2011 Bond project. Sealed bids to construct the project were received from five bidders on February 6, 2014. The bids ranged from a low of \$118,114.76 to a high of \$181,744.10. Additional details and a recommendation are available in the attached e-mail from Chan and Partners Engineers, the consultant hired to design

this project. Upon tabulation and reviewing the bids, TNR finds the low bid at \$118,114.76 to be complete. Subject to Purchasing Department's findings of responsiveness, and in accordance with Chapter 262 (c) of the Texas government Code, TNR requests that the low bidder, **Ceda-Tex Services, Inc.**, be awarded the contract for the construction of the Hunters Bend Sidewalk Improvements project. 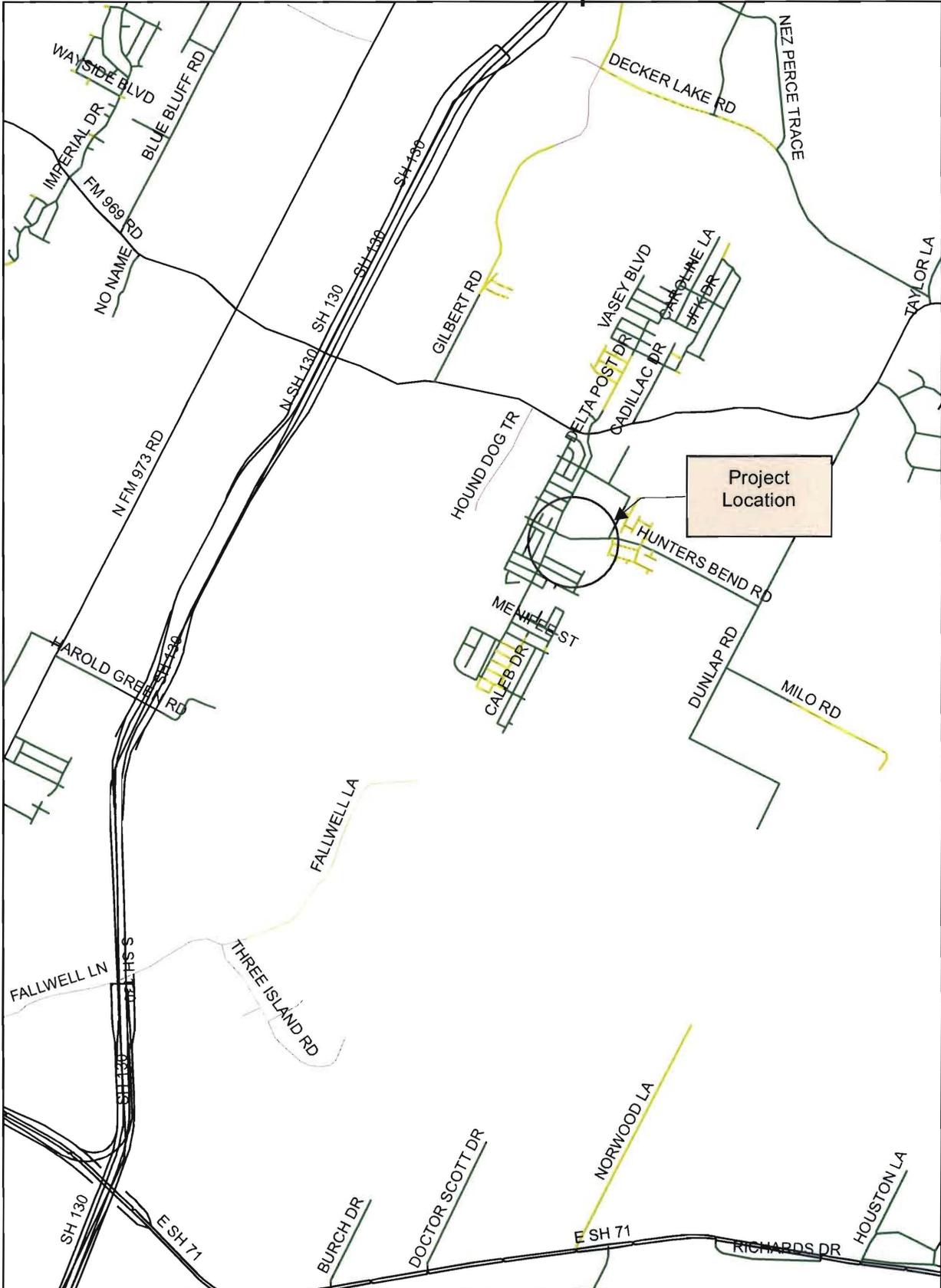

Lee,

I took a look at the bid tabulation for the referenced project, especially the lowest two bidders (low bidder is Ceda-Tex and second low bidder is CCG). There were a total of 5 bids; our estimate at \$180,308.20 was between the 3rd and 4th ranked bidders. I did not see anything in the bids that would cause me to recommend rejecting either bidder due to their bid prices. I did not see any unreasonable front-end loading of prices, except possibly the mobilization bid for CCG. The lowest bid at \$118,114.76 was \$62,193.44 lower than our estimate (34% lower than our estimate) and the second low bidder at \$125,948.00 was \$54,360.20 lower than our estimate (30% lower than our estimate). However, there are several bid items that cause concern that need to be monitored during construction (both through submittal review and through inspection) as follows:

Ceda-Tex

1. At their bid price for top soil (\$26.10/cy) the quality of the top soil will need to be monitored to confirm it is not waste soil from some other project.
2. The unit price for the sidewalk flume (\$4,874.00) is high. This in itself is not necessarily a problem, but indicates there concrete forming/placement capability is expensive. But their flatwork concrete prices for sidewalk (\$3.89/SF) and driveway (\$4.38/SF) are low. This indicates to me that if there is anything out of the normal for flatwork that they are not used to, their price will be high. They will need to submit all required flatwork submittals so we can confirm that they have included all the required elements of the flatwork in their bid, such as required expansion joints, joint sealants, bedding material, correct class of concrete mix design, correct reinforcement, etc. Inspection will be needed to conform correct depths of bedding and concrete, steel placement, correct concrete mix delivered to the site, etc. In addition they are to provide site layout surveys and provide grades that are ADA compliant.
3. The unit price for the curb ramp (\$650.00/ea) appears to be low for a single curb ramp. The curb ramps are more complicated than flatwork (e.g. the cone warning devices and flared wings). The curb ramps are susceptible to incorrect grades and not being ADA compliant. The installation of the curb ramp will have to be inspected closely.
4. Rock riprap unit price (\$60/SY) appears low but we will see in their submittal if they are proposing a rock gradation that meets specifications.
5. Native hardwood mulch unit price (\$7/sy) appears low. We specify 6" thickness so inspection will have to confirm thickness. Their submittal will allow us to determine if the product meets specifications.
6. The unit price for soil retention blanket (\$3/sy) appears to be low. We will need to see the submittal to confirm that the correct blanket product (Class2 Type E) is being proposed.
7. The unit price for the stabilized construction entrance (\$1800/ea) appears to be high. This cost can be reduced if it is determined in the field that only one stabilized entrance is needed (or none at all). A submittal of the proposed rock is required for this product.
8. Traffic handling unit price (\$55/CD) appears to be low. Contractor is paid only during the calendar days that traffic controls are in place. If traffic controls stay in place over the weekend, then every calendar day is included in the time. However, if only flagging is used, then only the days flagging is performed is payable. We need to see their traffic control submittals to determine if they are planning on adequate traffic controls and have proper trained personnel.

CCG

1. At their bid price for top soil (\$20/cy) the quality of the top soil will need to be monitored to confirm it is not waste soil from some other project.
2. The unit price for the curb (\$2.50/lf) is way below any other bid price by almost a factor of 10. This might have been a mistake.
3. The unit price for the 4" sidewalk (\$6/sf) seems about reasonable, but their unit price for the 5" driveway (\$5/sf) should be higher than the cost of the sidewalk.
4. Native hardwood mulch unit price (\$3/sy) appears low. We specify 6" thickness so inspection will have to confirm thickness. Their submittal will allow us to determine if the product meets specifications.
5. The unit price for tree protective fencing (\$10/lf) is high. This cost can be minimized by adjusting in the field only the footage of fencing needed.
6. The total mobilization payment (\$25,000) is high. This is 25% of the bid price (excluding the cost of mobilization). Contractor would need to justify this cost.
7. Traffic handling unit price (\$35/CD) appears to be low. Contractor is paid only during the calendar days that traffic controls are in place. If traffic controls stay in place over the weekend, then every calendar day is included in the time. However, if only flagging is used, then only the days flagging is performed is payable. We need to see their traffic control submittals to determine if they are planning on adequate traffic controls and have proper trained personnel.

This Agreement for Construction Services (the "Construction Contract" or "Contract") is made and entered into this day by and between Travis County, Texas, a political subdivision of the State of Texas (the "County") and **CEDA-TEX SERVICES, INC.** (the "Contractor") and will be binding upon their respective executors, administrators, heirs, successors, and assigns.

WHEREAS, the County desires to enter into a contract for the construction of **HUNTERS BEND ROAD SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT** in Travis County, Texas, in accordance with the provisions of state statutes and conforming to the Contractor's Notice of Construction, Bid Proposal (including the Bidding Documents, Bid Form, and any Addenda or Amendments thereto), General Conditions, Supplementary Conditions, and the Specifications and Plans **HUNTERS BEND ROAD SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT (B1401-004-LP)**, all of which are incorporated herein;

WHEREAS, the Contractor has been engaged in and now does comparable work and represents that it is fully equipped, competent, and capable of performing the above- desired and outlined work, and is ready and willing to perform such work in accordance with all provisions of the abovementioned Specifications and Plans marked **(B1401-004-LP)**.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the County's promise to pay the amount below as totaled in the Bid Proposal hereto attached and made part of this Contract, the Contractor agrees to do at his own proper cost and expense all the work necessary for the construction of **HUNTERS BEND ROAD SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT** in Travis County, Texas in accordance with the provisions of the aforementioned Contractor's Notice of Construction, the Bid Proposal as awarded by the Commissioners Court, and the Specifications and Plans marked **(B1401-004-LP)** to the satisfaction of the Executive Manager of the Transportation and Natural Resources Department of Travis County, Texas.

This contract document, the Contractor's Notice of Construction, the Bid Proposal (including the Bidding Documents, the Bid Form, and any Addenda or Amendments thereto), and the Specifications and Plans marked **(B1401-004-LP)** represents the entire and integrated contract between the County and the Contractor and supersedes all prior negotiations, representations, or agreements, either oral or written. This Contract may be amended only by written instrument signed by both the County and the Contractor.

The said Contractor further agrees to be available for work within 14 calendar days, and to complete the project within **45 working days**, after receiving a written "Notice to Proceed".

Travis County, Texas, in consideration of the full and true performance of the said work by said Contractor, hereby agrees and binds itself to pay to said Contractor the total contract sum of **\$118,114.76**. The Contract Sum is comprised of **\$73,234.87** for materials to be incorporated into the Project or completely consumed at the job site and services required by or integral to the performance of the contract and **\$44,879.89** for all other charges, including the cost of other services, overhead, materials which do not become part of the finished project or are reusable, and machinery or equipment and its accessory, repair, or replacement parts, and in the manner provided for, within 30 calendar days from the receipt of an acceptable invoice. This division of the contract amount is made for sales tax purposes only. The Contractor must maintain internal records to verify the division. The Contractor must make these records available upon the request of the Travis County Auditor.

This contract will be construed according to the laws of the State of Texas. The performance for this Contract must be in Travis County, and venue for any action will lie in

Contract No. 4400001806

Travis County, Texas. The Contractor warrants that the completed project must be adequate for the purposes intended.

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary herein, if Contractor is delinquent in payment of taxes at the time of invoicing, Contractor hereby assigns any payments to be made for service rendered under this Contract to the Travis County Tax Assessor-Collector for the payment of said delinquent taxes.

NO OFFICIAL, EMPLOYEE, AGENT, OR REPRESENTATIVE OF THE COUNTY HAS ANY AUTHORITY, EITHER EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED, TO AMEND THIS CONTRACT, EXCEPT SUCH EXPRESS AUTHORITY AS MAY BE GRANTED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF THE COUNTY.

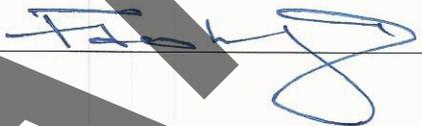

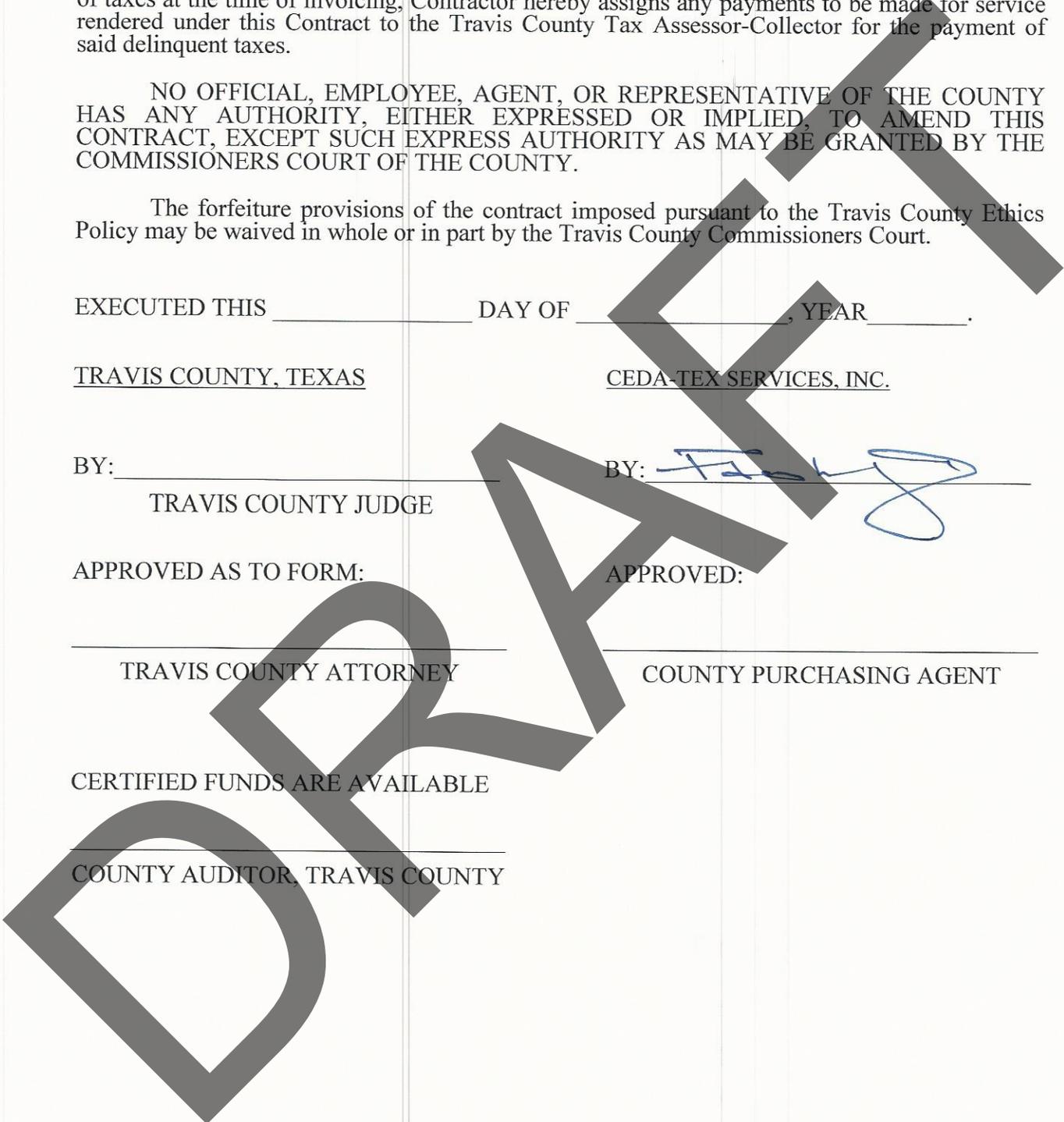
