




SUBJECT: RFS #S1404-010-LD Park Concession Operations proposals 2014

Travis County Parks recommends rejecting the two concession operations proposals received during the open RFS ending May 19, 2014.

World on a String submitted a proposal for concessions at Hippie Hollow park but withdrew their proposal.

PCBMX submitted a proposal for concessions at Northeast Metropolitan park. At this time we do not recommend proceeding with entering into a contract with PCBMX. Travis County Parks is pursuing other means of concession revenue similar to the rentable concession pads at the Northeast Metro Skate Park. This alternative would generate more revenue and be easier to monitor.
