Those speaking will be Mayor Leffingwell for a welcome to our Intercity Trip attendees , then Mike Rollins, Austin Chamber President followed by Paul DiGiuseppe, Principal Planner for the City of Austin, who will enlighten us on the subject of Imagine Austin.

This will be our 20th consecutive year to conduct our annual Intercity Trip. Below you will find a description of that Trip:

The Greater Columbus Georgia Chamber of Commerce will host its 2014 Intercity Leadership Conference with a departure from Columbus, Georgia on Wednesday, September 24, 2014 to Austin, Texas and then return to Columbus, Georgia on Friday, September 26, 2014.

As in the 20 previous consecutive years with our Intercity Trip, the focus of the trip will be to learn the strengths and best practices of a city like Austin Texas's involvement with: healthcare; economic development; public/private partnerships; workforce development; education, amateur sports, tourism, performing and cultural arts; military services; governmental services, quality of life, film commission, downtown revitalization just to mention of few of the subjects among many items of interest.

Our group will consist of about 130 governmental employees, business and healthcare leaders, educators, sports and tourism officials as well as other
