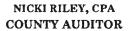

PBO recommends approval of this item totaling \$159,577.00 in new revenue to be used for park purposes. These funds can be used for the acquisition or improvement of parks that will benefit the subdivision connected to the received funds. Funds may also be used at other parks provided the received funds benefit all County residents and have typically supplemented funding for large capital park projects. Re: Use of centrally budgeted maintenance agreement funds for new storage

During the FY 2015 budget process Information Technology Services (ITS) budgeted \$1,164,681 for storage system maintenance based off vendor quotes available at that time. After negotiation with the vendor, ITS found that they may purchase new storage devices that have reduced ongoing maintenance costs and offer more storage capacity for less money due to recent innovations in storage technology. ITS would like to use these savings on a one time basis. Therefore, they are requesting to transfer \$328,237 in their hardware/software maintenance agreement commitment item to purchase additional terabyte storage devices.

Each budget cycle, ITS "zero-based budgets" this commitment item to account for old agreements ending and new agreements needed for new infrastructure. The total budget for maintenance agreements is \$8,353,698. ITS expects \$394,927 in ongoing realized savings and will use these funds to reduce the amount of new resources for maintenance agreements needed for FY 2016. PBO recommends approval of this transfer.

SUBJECT: Request to Re-allocate Maintenance Funds for Purchase of Equipment.

ITS requests Commissioners Court approval to use \$328,237 from the centrally budgeted ITS Maintenance Budget Commitment Item (1120040001 511550) to replace the two oldest storage devices currently in use instead of continuing maintenance to extend their life.

Through our vendor Mark III Systems, the County can acquire new and better performing storage devices that will provide 358 Terra Bytes (TBs), compared to 314 TBs, for our the new maintenance contract period effective at the end of December. The proposed devices will provide the County with enhanced management tools and an increased capability to deal with varied storage platforms, increasing ITS' agility while satisfying future storage needs. This exchange is possible due to innovation in the storage industry and the corresponding trend of declining costs per TB units of storage.

In preparation for the FY15 budget process, based on a vendor quote, ITS budgeted \$1,164,681 for the on-going maintenance of this equipment. With this proposed change and other cost reductions, ITS would pay \$769,754 per year and recognize an annual savings of \$394,927. That savings would be used to fund the purchase of this hardware in FY15. For the FY16 Budget Process, ITS will work with PBO to ensure these realized savings are used to offset other maintenance contract increases.
